	1.	27/09/2023	<p>It is a clear case of negligence that is apparent from the imaging that was done at CMC Vellore on a curative surgery.</p> <p>The patient was admitted for Caesarean Section. However, there had been post surgical complication having immense pain abdomen. Ultimately, it was found that a mop was left behind that could be taken out through curative surgery at CMC, Vellore. There were lot of complications including infection and intestinal obstruction.</p> <p>The patient is still not cured and the patient would need further surgery.</p> <p>We direct the CE to refund Rs. 30,500/- that they took</p>

at the time of surgery. The money must be refunded within seven days from date.

With regard to the CMC, Vellore bill we find, Rs. 2.668 lakhs was paid as in-patient bill.

We direct the CE to pay the said sum in six equal monthly instalments commencing from 15th October and thereafter on the 15th day of each succeeding month.

We direct the CMOH, Purulia to personally monitor the payment schedule and in case of default of anyone instalment the establishment must be closed down at once and the defaulted amount would immediately become payable along with interest at the rate of 7 percent per annum until realisation.

This direction for payment was just for reimbursement of the expenses that the patient had to incur.

We refer the issue to the West Bengal Medical Council or Bihar Medical Council as the case be, to initiate appropriate proceeding against the concerned doctor. After completion of the proceeding before the



Medical Council the complainant would be free to approach us afresh for appropriate compensation as against the CE.

We also direct the CMOH, Purulia to keep a strict vigil on the establishment and ensure that all doctors attending patients at the CE, must be having registration with West Bengal Medical Council . This would help us to deal with the case of medical and hospital negligence that is arising in the bordering districts.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.


