		<p>equal monthly instalments commencing from January 15, 2024 and thereafter 15th day of the each succeeding month.</p> <p>In default of payment of any one instalment, the defaulted amount would become immediately payable along with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum until realisation.</p> <p>The complainant is directed to share his bank details with the CE so that money could be transferred to his account directly.</p> <p>We request the CMOH, Hooghly to make a thorough investigation at the centre to find out whether the present doctors working thereat, are properly qualified to do the tests which are being done at the centre.</p> <p>We would also request CMOH, Hooghly to take adequate measure and report back to us.</p> <p>The complaint is disposed of.</p>
