The balance amount had to be paid by the complainant.</p> <p>In course of hearing, Mr. Sudhir Agarwal representing the Finance Department of Kothari, has offered Rs. 1.5 lac as lumpsum discount. He would assure, as soon as the bank details are provided by the complainant the money would be transferred.</p> <p>Since Mr. Agarwal has made this offer we refrain</p>



from taking any action against the CE however, we hope and trust, they would reframe their tariff chart and the billing process so that these kind of irregularities does not recur in future.
