	1.	20/02/2024	<p>This complaint would relate to treatment of a critical patient.</p> <p>Our esteemed member Dr Sukumar Mukherjee is of the opinion that the patient was having congested heart failure with a bilateral pleural effusion and enlarged prostate.</p> <p>The treatment records would show that the treating team was keen more on prostate than the prime issue. However, this is our primary opinion. Medical negligence is outside our domain. The matter may be looked into by the appropriate authority.</p> <p>We permit the complainant to approach the West Bengal Medical Council. The CE is directed to share all medical records including the details of the doctors who</p>

treated the patient so that the complainant could approach the West Bengal Medical Council with all details.

On perusal of the records, we find infrastructural deficiency. We direct the CMOH to make a thorough inquiry and submit a report to the Commission with a copy endorsed to the complainant as well as the CE.

In case the CMOH finds any irregularity he must take appropriate action on such irregularity upon notice to the Commission.

The complaint is disposed of.
