	1.	05/03/2024	<p>The complaint would relate to unfit certificate given by the CE.</p> <p>Despite notice the CE is absent.</p> <p>The complainant would contend, he would require a fitness certificate to join service at Soudi Arabia. The centre gave an unfit certificate. He then approached Apollo Hospital which has given him a fit certificate.</p> <p>According to him, the CE has not properly examined him medically. Had it been done so he would have been declared fit. We request the Director, Health Service, State of West Bengal, to make a thorough investigation as to whether the concerned centre is authorised to do the fitness test or not. In case any</p>

irregularity is found steps should be taken accordingly.

We direct refund of the sum of Rs. 6,500/- that was deposited for medical examination.

We also impose a penalty of Rs. 5,000/- for being absent today despite repeated notices given by us.

The complainant is directed to share his bank details with the CE so that money could be refunded to him along with the penalty.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.
