	1.	14/08/2024	<p>The complaint would relate to unnatural death of a mentally ill patient undergoing treatment at the CE. According to the CE, on the fateful day, he became agitated after launch and tried to forcefully leave the hospital and in the process, fell down from the staircase and got injured.</p> <p>He was ultimately transferred to R.G. Kar Medical College where he breathed his last after a brief treatment for about seven days.</p> <p>The complainant lodged a complaint with the police authority. According to her, the police had not been taking any active step in the matter compelling her to file</p>

a Writ Petition before the Hon'ble High Court through her brother Sri Hari Narayan Chakraborty being W.P.A No. 19922 of 2012.

The said Writ Petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Raja Sekhar Mantha vide order dated May 15, 2023. The relevant paragraph is quoted below:- “

- i) *“The petitioner is aggrieved by the investigation into FIR being Madhyamgram Police Station Case No. 334 of 2022 dated July 12, 2022 under section 304A/34 of the IPC.*
- ii) *The petitioner's nephew who was undergoing treatment at a medical facility is stated to have fallen down the stair and sustained serious injuries on July 3, 2023. He was admitted to R.G. Kar Medical College and Hospital and died on July 11, 2023. Post-mortem has been conducted and the FIR has been registered.*
- iii) *It is submitted by Mr. Kaustav Bagchi, Learned Counsel for the petitioner that after the incident, the principal accused in the FIR, i.e.*

head of the medical facility, obtained a sum of Rs. 30,000/- from his client.

iv) The accused has obtained anticipatory bail and was arrested and set at liberty.”

We are told, the criminal case is still pending and awaiting its disposal.

During pendency of the criminal proceeding the ill-fated mother of the victim has come up before us for appropriate compensation.

In our view, once the criminal case is pending it would be prudent for us to wait till a logical conclusion is arrived at by the criminal court.

We request the police authority particularly Superintendent of Police, 24 Parganas (North) to take suitable measure so that the ill-fated mother of the victim gets justice at the earliest.

We grant liberty to the complainant to approach us afresh if occasion so arises in future.

The complaint is disposed of.
