	1.	14/08/2024	<p>The complaint would relate to unnatural death of a mentally ill patient undergoing treatment at the CE. According to the CE, on the fateful day, he became agitated after launch and tried to forcefully leave the hospital and in the process, fell down from the staircase and got injured.</p> <p>He was ultimately transferred to R.G. Kar Medical College where he breathed his last after a brief treatment for about seven days.</p> <p>The complainant lodged a complaint with the police authority. According to her, the police had not been taking any active step in the matter compelling her to file</p>

			<p>a Writ Petition before the Hon'ble High Court through her brother Sri Hari Narayan Chakraborty being W.P.A No. 19922 of 2012.</p> <p>The said Writ Petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Raja Sekhar Mantha vide order dated May 15, 2023. The relevant paragraph is quoted below:- “</p> <p>i) <i>“The petitioner is aggrieved by the investigation into FIR being Madhyamgram Police Station Case No. 334 of 2022 dated July 12, 2022 under section 304A/34 of the IPC.</i></p> <p>ii) <i>The petitioner's nephew who was undergoing treatment at a medical facility is stated to have fallen down the stair and sustained serious injuries on July 3, 2023. He was admitted to R.G. Kar Medical College and Hospital and died on July 11, 2023.
