| | 1. | 28/04/2025 | <p>The complaint would principally relate to medical negligence.</p> <p>The patient had uncontrolled blood pressure that caused hypertensive urgency on January 12, 2025 detected at 5.30 p.m. at the emergency of the CE.</p> <p>The CE would contend, the patient refused admission and went back home.</p> <p>At about 7-7.30p.m,the patient attended the chamber of Dr. Deepanjan Bhattacharya who is associated with the CE.</p> |





On perusal of the prescription of Dr. Bhattacharya made on the same day at 7.30 p.m. it appears, he had hypertensive urgency. TIA was mentioned with a question mark. At the end of the prescription the patient was advised "admission SOS" and thereafter review after "two months/sos".

From the emergency sheet it also appears that the patient had been detected hypertension before one year although the complainant present online would categorically deny so. From the prescription we do not find any such recording although Dr Bhattacharya is not only associated with the CE but also representing them at the hearing before us.

On January 23, 2025 the patient had a stroke and was admitted at the CE. Within a very short span of time, the patient had gone to a comatic



stage.

The patient was ultimately taken to Institute of Neuro Science. The patient ultimately breathed his last there on January 29, 2025.

Our esteemed medical members are of the opinion, had the patient been admitted on January 12, 2025 the patient could be saved by rapid control of blood pressure.

The contention of the CE that the patient refused admission, was not documented.

In any event, the medical issues are outside our domain. The complainant would be free to approach the appropriate authority. In case they are successful therein they would be at liberty to approach us afresh.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.
