	1.	16/07/2025	<p>The complaint would relate to USG report in case of Cholelithiasis.</p> <p>The first USG would show multiple calculus present in the gallbladder one of which is 8.1ml. The surgery was planned however, the complainant, father of the child, did not agree with the findings and got the patient discharged under DAMA. Repeat USG was done after seven days at two different establishments where no calculus was found and gallbladder was found to be normal. Hence, this complaint questioning the first USG report.</p>





On our request, Dr. Sukharanjan Hawlader, HOD, Radiology, IPGMER, is present. Dr. Hawlader, would opine, since the patient is a minor there is every possibility of gallbladder having debris that might have caused infection. Subsequently with a gap of seven days those got removed in normal course. Hence, the second USG report did not show any calculus in the gallbladder.

We intend to give the Sonologist benefit of doubt.

We do not feel inclined to interfere.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.
