	1.	27/05/2019	<p>This complaint was lodged at a time when the patient was under treatment of the Clinical Establishment. The petitioner would now claim, because of wrong advice of the Doctor, there had been complication during surgery and ultimately surgery could not be done and the patient went in coma. Ultimately, he was put on ventilation. After 34 days of stay, mostly in ICU, he was discharged.</p> <p>The Clinical Establishment charged a sum of Rs.9.58 lacs at the time of discharge. After series of negotiations the bill could be settled at Rs. 5.5 lacs that the petitioner paid at the time of discharge.</p> <p>Since the bill was settled by the parties and the petitioner got substantial discount, we do not find any scope to interfere on that score.</p> <p>The petitioner has serious grievance as against the anaesthetist, Dr. Samar Chackraborty and treating cardiologist, Dr. P.K Hazra. The petitioner would be at liberty to approach the West Bengal Medical Council against the anaesthetist and the Cardiologist, if they so like.</p>
