	3.	27/06/2019	<p>This is a case of an unfortunate death of a young man of 32 years who succumbed to injury in a motor bike accident. The petitioner, being the widow of the deceased, filed a complaint alleging medical negligence of the clinical establishment. Mr. Mainak Bose Learned Counsel appearing for the clinical establishment would submit his written submission. According to Mr. Bose, medical literature would support the conservative treatment that was given by the clinical establishment to the patient. However, the patient did not respond to the treatment and succumbed to the injury.</p> <p>In course of hearing, in deference to the desire of the members of the Commission, Mr. Bose using his good office could persuade the clinical establishment to have a desirable solution to the issue.</p> <p>The young man had twin babies being Seejoy Paul and Sejashri Paul. They are now two years old. Mr. Bose, on instruction, would inform this Commission, the establishment would make two fixed</p>

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deposits of Rs. 10lacs each in the name of two minor children in UCO Bank, Bamungachhi Branch, Howrah. The fixed deposit interest would be deposited month by month in savings account of the children maintained by their mother being complainant at the said bank so that she could maintain her children. Mr. Bose, on instruction, would also inform us, the entire process would be done preferably within a month from date and positively not later than three months from date.

In view of the above statement made by the clinical establishment we refrain from interfering with the complain.

The complaint is disposed of.

Before parting with we would failing in our duty if do not acknowledge the contribution of Mr. Bose, his able junior Mr. Cedric Fernandez We also appreciate the gesture shown by the doctors and officers of the clinical establishment present before us.

We are told, criminal proceeding was initiated by the local police station. The petitioner's father-in-law is present. He assures this Commission, they would not pursue the complaint at Alipore Police Station.
