Mr. Partha Pratim Seth, the General Manager of the Clinical Establishment would inform us, the untoward incident that happened at the Clinical Establishment after the death of the patient has resulted in a criminal proceeding that is pending before the appropriate criminal court. We would feel, it would be just and appropriate to grant liberty to the applicant to approach us again against the hospital negligence after disposal of the said two proceedings. We do so.</p> <p>We are, however, satisfied on one issue where we are shown the photograph of the patient's left hand where we find complicated Intravenous Infusion leading to wide ulceration for which the Clinical Establishment could not offer any plausible explanation. We award a token compensation of Rs. 20,000/- that the Clinical Establishment would pay to the complainant within a month from date by account</p>
