	1.	31/10/2019	<p>The Complainant is absent. On perusal of the complaint we find, the complainant did not have any grievance as against the treatment. However, he raised certain issues that the Clinical Establishment has tried to give explanation. We have considered the same. In our view, when the patient was admitted in a critical care unit, there cannot be a separate charge on RMO's service.</p> <p>We direct the Clinical Establishment to give due credit on this score.</p> <p>We are told out of the billed amount of Rs 8.5 lakhs, a some of Rs 4.5 lakhs is still due and payable. The Complainant issued post dated cheques for the said amount that are dishonoured for non-payment.</p> <p>We grant liberty to the clinical establishment to take appropriate legal measure, if they so choose. However, in case they opt for taking any measure for recovery they should give appropriate deduction on account of the RMO charges. With this direction the complaint is disposed off.</p>
