	1.	08/01/2020	<p>The complaint would pertain to post MTP complication for which the treating doctor volunteered to support the patient party because of their precarious condition. Concerned treating doctor paid a sum of Rs.4, 39, 301/- for the patient's treatment when the patient was sent to higher set up for proper management. We are told, patient is now stable. The complainant would now pray for reimbursement of the further medical expenses to the extent of Rs.7, 45, 181/- that they spent at Mission Hospital, Durgapur.</p> <p>Our experts have gone through the medical records. It is not proved that the complication was due to medical negligence of the doctor. Moreover, we cannot brush aside the fact that the concerned treating doctor volunteered to support the patient for her treatment.</p> <p>We do not find any scope to interfere. This order would however, not preclude the complainant to approach the West Bengal Medical Council, if he is so advised.</p> <p>The complaint is disposed of.</p>
