The total bill comes to Rs. 82,818.78 /- out of which the TPA sanctioned a sum of Rs. 73,659 /-. The CE discounted the bill to the extent of Rs. 3,478/- leaving a sum of Rs. 5,682/- that the complainant paid. In course of hearing, Mr. Dashora would agree to refund the said sum hence, we do not wish to interfere on this issue and leave it to the complainant to approach the appropriate authority on his main grievance.</p> <p>The complainant is directed to share his bank details with the CE so that money could be transferred to his account.</p>
