According to him, he offered Kshara-Sutra treatment and advised him fifteen days bed rest. The patient did not adhere to his advice. Hence, he has no responsibility.</p> <p>We feel, this question could be effectively gone into and decided by the West Bengal Ayurvedic Council.</p>

Let the complaint be sent to the Council for appropriate decision. In case the complainant is successful therein he would be at liberty to apply afresh.
