	1.	16/11/2022	<p>The complaint would relate to medical negligence that would be outside our domain. The complainant in his petition has contended, “few of the pages” of the medical records were missing. The page numbers have not been specified in the complaint. Our office contacted the complainant inter-alia asking for details of those missing pages. He did not comply with such request.</p> <p>We once again permit the complainant to write to the CE indicating the pages that according to him, are missing from the medical records.</p> <p>The CE is directed to provide those pages within a week from the date of the receipt of such communication.</p> <p>The complainant is given liberty to approach the</p>

appropriate authority on the issue of medical negligence. If he is successful therein he would be at liberty to approach us afresh.

As like other cases, we have also examined the bill. There are some areas where we need clarification from the CE. However, on a query made by us, the CE would inform us, the entire bill was cleared by TPA and the claimant portion has been waived by the CE. In such circumstances, we do not wish to interfere on the issue.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.
