	1.	13/03/2023	<p>The complaint would relate to medical negligence as well as hospital negligence.</p> <p>The patient was critically ill. She reported at the Emergency with the history of vomiting and burning sensation in the chest and abdomen. The concerned cardiologist attended the patient who planned PTCA on the next day i.e, December 17, 2022.</p> <p>From the BHT it appears that at about 11 p.m. the concerned doctor recorded that the patient was hemo-dynamically stable and PTCA was planned on that day. However, it was not done.</p>



		<p>The Medical Superintendent is present online. He is however not in a position to give any plausible explanation why such procedure was not done. According to the Medical Super, it was a case of 100 per cent blockage. Bye pass was thus the right procedure. The progress note in the BHT would demonstrate otherwise.</p> <p>The doctors present at the panel are unanimous of the view, the case must be examined by the appropriate authority as to whether there was any medical negligence or not. It is a fit and proper case to refer it to the West Bengal Medical Council.</p> <p>We grant liberty to the complainant to approach West Bengal Medical Council. In case they are successful they would be at liberty to approach us afresh.</p> <p>There are instances of hospital negligence that</p>
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would be overlapping. We reserve our comments on those issues. We would examine those in case the complainant would come back to us after West Bengal Medical Council proceeding.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.
