As per advice of the doctor, he was administered three injections being Rantac, Zofer and Taxim and it had reaction.</p> <p>According to the CE, the patient had acute coronary syndrome. He was immediately rushed to Ramkrishna Mission Seva Patisthan and cured accordingly.</p> <p>The complainant has come with the complaint that the injections that were pushed, were not properly explained to him. Details of such injections were not</p>



mentioned in the discharge summary.

According to the CE, since there had been sudden deterioration of the patient condition priority was to send him to a higher set-up. The patient was immediately taken to the Ramkrishna Mission Seva Patisthan and was taken care of.

We do not find any scope to interfere.

The complaint is disposed of accordingly.
